Program Goal

Sustained improvement in municipal service delivery to better address the basic needs of citizens located in three urban areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa



Program Objectives

- 1. Improve basic service delivery in a more transparent and accountable manner through
 - Municipal Infrastructure upgrade- safe water, sanitation, solid waste collection and disposal, markets, sewerage services, streets and street lighting
 - Citizen Engagement high degree of citizen involvement in identification, implementation and operation of all activities leading to co- ownership and better delivery
 - Municipal Management Systems reform- governance assessment, financial management and accounting software, service billing and collecting systems, transparent budget reviews
- 2. Establish a collaborative partner relationship between USAID and Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa for urban sector policy, program design and implementation
- 3. Upgrade provincial information systems for planning, operations and Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E)
- 4. Deepen the capacities of local government administration



Salient Features

- The Program will be implemented through existing government systems leading to
 - Improve sustainability of program interventions
 - Build government's capacity in medium to longer term
 - Better linkages and full ownership by the departments
- The Program is a combination of infrastructure improvements, institutional development and community participation as well as empowerment



Progress to-date

In anticipation of the Program, Government of KP with the assistance of USAID, UNICEF and World Bank (WSP-SA) has:

- Completed Water Distribution System Study in Town-1 of Peshawar city;
- Developed detailed design for up-gradation of Water infrastructure in Town-1, estimated cost: \$35 million
- Initiated work on Sanitation System Study in Town-1
- Household survey on Knowledge, Attitude and Practice in Town-1
- Pilot study in five Union Councils of Town-1 for social mobilization to compliment infrastructure up-gradation
- Financing of establishment cost of institutional set-up for Peshawar Water and Sanitation Authority (P-WASA)
- Design of a Behaviour Change Communications Strategy in Water & Sanitation sector is in process
- Development of a W&S Policy for the province
- Financing of establishment cost of of Urban Unit in P&D Department on the of pattern of Punjab



Future Plans for MSDP

- Implementation of infrastructure up-gradation in Town-1
- Conduct similar studies and designs for infrastructure up-gradation in remaining Towns of Peshawar
- Establishment and functionalization of P-WASA and Urban Unit
- Development of land-use and zoning Master Plan, implementation arrangements and monitoring for Peshawar
- Development of Peshawar Water Master Plan with emphasis on using surface water from Warsak and Bara dams
