

**E-TENDER NOTICE FOR
CONSTRUCTION/ REHABILITATION OF DRAINS, WATER AND SANITATION
IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC TOILETS PESHAWAR.**

The USAID has provided funds to finance the Construction/ Rehabilitation of Drains, Water and Sanitation improvement Projects and Construction of Public Toilets in Peshawar under Municipal Services Program (MSP) through Project Management Unit (PMU), Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, to make eligible payment under the Contract for which this E-Tender Notice is issued. The details are as under:

- 1) **MSP-1/PMU/DR-05:** Water and Sanitation Improvement Project Peshawar Town-1, Galbahar Drainage Upgrade.
- 2) **MSP-1/PMU/DR-09:** Water and Sanitation Improvement Project Peshawar Town-1, Afridi Garhi to Gulbahar Drainage
- 3) **MSP-1/PMU/DR-11:** Water and Sanitation Improvement Project Peshawar Town-1, Muhammad Zai Drain to Waste water Treatment Plant.
- 4) **MSP-1/PMU/WS-04:** Water and Sanitation Improvement Project Peshawar Town-1, Rehabilitation of 42 No Water Supply Tube Wells in UCs 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7 & 8 in Zone A.
- 5) **MSP-1/PMU/WS-05:** Water and Sanitation Improvement Project Peshawar Town-1, Rehabilitation of 58 No Water Supply Tube Wells in UCs 9 to 16, 18 to 23, and 26 to 30 in Zone B.
- 6) **MSP-1/PMU/WS-06:** Water and Sanitation Improvement Project Peshawar Town-1, Rehabilitation of 21 No Water Supply Tube Wells in UCs 37 to 42 in Zone D.
- 7) **MSP-1/PMU/PT-01C:** Construction of Public Toilet at Kohat Road, Peshawar.
- 8) **MSP-1/PMU/PT-02A:** Construction of Public Toilet at Charsadda Bus Terminal, Peshawar.
- 9) **MSP-1/PMU/PT-02B:** Construction of Public Toilet at Karkhano Bus Terminal, Peshawar.
- 10) **MSP-1/PMU/PT-02C:** Construction of Public Toilet at Grain Market, Peshawar.

Project Management Unit (PMU) invites sealed bids from PEC registered contractors (who have paid their registration/renewal fee for the Years 2015-16) under “**Single Stage Two Envelopes**” bidding procedures of KPPRA Rules. Contractors / Firms of the Category **C-1 & above** having relevant experience of carrying-out similar Works, may apply for Packages at Sr. No. 1 to 6 while **C-2 & above** for Packages at Sr. No. 7 to 10.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Interested Contractors must register with the MSP, LGE & RD Deptt: two days prior to the closing date of bid-submission.
2. Tender Forms & BOQ's can be downloaded from MSP Website www.msppk.gov.pk upto **October 19th, 2015**.
3. Sealed Bids through registered Mail/ Courier shall reach on **October 20th, 2015** before **1:00 PM** (Pakistan Standard Time) in PMU and will be opened on the same day at **2:00 PM** in the Office of Project Management Unit (PMU) MSP in presence of the Bidders. No Bid shall be considered for opening if it's submitted by Hand or any other unregistered source or after the above mentioned time.
4. Earnest Money as mentioned in Tender documents must be accompanied with the Technical proposal in the shape of call deposit issued from any Branch of Scheduled Bank's in Pakistan in the name of Project Director, MSP, LGE & RDD.
5. Documents including attested updated copy of PEC Registration, NIC and NTN Certificates shall be accompanied in a separate envelope with the documents.
6. A **Non-refundable fee of Rs.5000/-** for Tender Form / document shall be deposited by the Contractor in the Treasury office, Peshawar in the Govt: Budget Head G-10408-P.W.

Remittances in favour of Project Director, MSP, LGE & RDD, and the deposit slip (in original) shall be accompanied with the Technical proposal documents.

7. Each and every page of the Tender document must be stamped and signed by the person whose name exists in **Form-H/ Partnership deed**.
8. The Contractors quoting their rates on **above/ below** basis on Item Rate in BOQ/ tender form should be termed as defective to avoid complications at the time of Evaluation of bids.
9. The Bidders are required to send their Bids in duplicate in separate sealed envelopes clearly marked as original & duplicate. The original shall be sent to the **Project Director MSP, PMU Peshawar** and the duplicate to **COP, Halcrow, 51-C-II, Park Avenue Road, University Town, Peshawar, and K.P.K Pakistan**.
10. Bank Guarantee or in lieu therefore, an equivalent insurance coverage of a company having at least **“AA” Rating from PACRA/JCR** shall be acceptable from Contractors/ Bidders quoting upto 10% below on Engineer’s cost estimate/ BOQ, while Bank guarantees of equivalent amount shall be obtained from Contractors/ Bidders quoting more than 10% below on Engineer’s cost estimate/BOQ. These guarantees will be discharged on expiry of the defect liability of Contractors as per **Finance Department Notification No.SO (FR)/FD/9-7/2011/Volume-II dated 05-11-2014**.
11. All federal and provincial duties/ stamp duty /taxes including sales tax etc shall be recoverable as per directives of the Govt: issued from time to time.
12. Rejection of all Tender proposals is subject to approval by Head of the Procuring Entity. The tender accepting authority may reject all tenders, proposals, offers or quotations at any time prior to the acceptance of such Tender proposal, offer or quotations. However before rejection of Tender on the basis of the Bid being unworkable, the Bidder shall upon request be given an opportunity to give a detailed analysis of workability of his/her bid.
13. Bidding shall be done on **Item Rate Systems**. Bidders should fill their own rates/ amounts in the blank columns against each item of the BOQ. In case no rates are filled against any item, the same will have to be executed by the Contractor at his own cost as per specifications.
14. A pre- bid meeting will be held on **October 15th, 2015 at 10:00 AM** in the MSP Office Peshawar.
15. If any documents submitted along with bid documents found forged/ false, the registration of the Contractor/ Firm shall be cancelled/ black listed.
16. Any disfiguring/ over writing manipulation in the Tender shall be liable to rejection.
17. Only the first two figures after the **decimal (without rounding)** of the rate will be considered for evaluation of the bid.
18. Incomplete/ conditional bid shall not be accepted.
19. Any information/ condition can be obtained from the MSP Office during working hours on below Address.
20.
